





# Constitution of the Pakistan Wrestling Federation

### NAME

The organisation shall be called the "Pakistan Wrestling Federation". The Headquarters of the Federation shall be in the city where the Secretary resides.

II. The jurisdiction of the Pakistan Wrestling Federation shall extend throughout Pakistan, the acceeding States and the territories under the control of the Government of Pakistan.

## III. AIMS AND OBJECTS.

The aims and objects of the P.W.F. shall be:

To encourage, promote assist and control in the development of wrestling in Pakistan.

- To organise contests and championships in wrestling and authorise the holding of these contests as often as possible, the National Championships being held every year.
- To cause the formation of Regional organisations and affiliate them.

To arrange, assist, finance, if required and encourage, systematic training of wrestlers

- 5. To arrange and finance Pakistan representative teams for participation in international championships and other contests of international nature.
- To certify the status of Pakistan's wrestlers wherever required.

- 8. To do all such things that may be ancillary to the attainment of the above aims and objects.

### IV. MEMBERSHIP.

### . MEMBERSHIP FEE

- 1. The patron-in-Chief, President and Vice Presidents shall be members of the PWF without payment of any membership fee.
- 2. Organisations affiliated to the Federation shall pay annual membership fee of Rs. 200/.
- The membership fee shall fall due on the first of July each year and shall be paid within three months from the date it falls due.

- t. No members shall be entitled to vote at any meeting of the PWF while his fee is in arrears.
- . Members failing to pay the fee within the time fixed may be dismembered by the PWF.
- 6. All the new applications for membership must be accompanied by the requisite membership fee without which an application shall not be considered.
- 7. Once a member is dismembered for non-payment of fee by the PWF readmission will not be allowed unless all arrears and in addition a penalty to be fixed by the General Meeting shall have been paid in advance.
- 8. The PWF's financial year shall be from Ist July to the following 30th June.

## VI. GENERAL MEETING

1. The supreme authority shall vest in the General Meeting, which shall consist of representatives of affiliated Organisations. Such representatives may be Presidents, Vice Presidents or Secretaries of affiliated organisations or any other Members, nominated by them.

### IX. ARBITRATION

A dispute amongst the members organisations shall be referred to an Arbitrator(s) to be appointed by the next higher organisation. The award of the Arbitrator(s) shall be deemed as final.

EXAMPLE: For instance a dispute at the Tehsil level will be referred to the President of the District Association who will appoint an Arbitrator(s), receive the award and communicate it to the President of the Tehsil Association for implmentation.

Addispute at District level will be dealt with as laid down above at the Provincial level and the dispute at the Provincial level will be dealt with at the Federation level.

In any case no affiliated member or official or any competitor has the right to go to the Court of Law until the matter has ben decided by the General Council of the Federation and appeal rejected by the Pakistan Olympic Association.

Any member, official, wrestler or coach, giving statements in the Press or passing derogatory remarks or going over the head of the Federation to the Ministry or to the Pakistan Sports Board, shall be debarred for a period to be fixed by the Executive Committee.

## X. MISCELLANEOUS;

2. In case of emergent matters when holding of a meeting is not possible, the Secretary may obtain the decision of the members by post or by telegram votes and act according to the majority vote provided the votes so obtained are preserved in the PWF record and the matter is laid at the next meeting for approval. If, however, there is no time to take postal votes, then the Secretary may take a decision after obtaining order from the President.

3. No amendment to these rules shall be made except at a General Meeting, provided due notice of the proposed amendment is given to the members at least 15 days before the date of the meeting. Such amendment shall be adopted by a two-third majority of the members attending the meeting.

4. Any matter not covered by these Rules shall be decided by the General Meeting by a majority of votes.

If, however, there is no time to take postal votes, then the Honorary General Secretary may take a decision after obtaining orders from the Chairman in writing through President.

### Item # 3 Audited Accounts for FY 2012-13

5. The House was apprised by the Honorary Secretary that possession of the office of Pakistan Wrestling Federation situated in Olympic House, Lahore has been forcibly taken by the illegal body of POA along with all record, including original receipts and vouchers; therefore, the audited accounts cannot be presented before the House for approval. A

complaint with local police has also been lodged. However, whenever the matter is resolved and the possession of the office is taken back, the audited accounts will be presented before the House. The House condemned the unlawful action of illegal and so-called POA and decided as under:

- a. The Audited Accounts for the period from 1.7.2012 to 2.9.2013 shall be presented before the House as soon as matter is resolved and the possession of office and record is taken back.
- b. The Honorary General Secretary and Treasurer should ensure that accounts of PWF are updated and maintained as per funds in our Bank Accounts and cash in hand w.e.f. 2.9.2013 and onward for the perusal and approval of Executive Committee in the forthcoming meeting.
- c. Accounts of the Pakistan Wrestling Federation (Account No.11808-09) in Habib Bank Ltd. Opp High Court, Lahore, will now be operated by the Treasurer, General Secretary and President.
- d. Pakistan Wrestling Federation may open a new account in any Bank, if needed for convenience, which will also be operated by the Treasurer, General Secretary and President.
- e. President and Honorary General Secretary are authorized to vigorously follow up the FIR case for repossession of the office at 2-Temple Road Lahore.

### <u>Item # 4</u> Election of Office Bearers of PWF for the next term of 4 years

6. Ch. Muhammad Asghar, Honorary Secretary PWF informed the House regarding the prevailing legal aspects in the country and proposed the House to elect the new office bearers in compliance to the national and international requirements to ensure its affiliation with all the relevant organizations for the elevation of wrestling in Pakistan. The House considering the proposal of the Secretary unanimously commended the valuable contribution of Syed Aqil Shah and Ch. Muhammad Asghar for the promotion of wrestling both at national and international platforms. The House unanimously declared that the continuation of the current policies are imperative for the promotion of the wrestling. Thereafter Mr. Khalid Hassan, rep of Punjab proposed that Syed Aqil Shah may be elected as Chairman of the Federation and Ch. Muhammad Asghar may be elected as President as per the amended PWF Constitution. He also proposed a panel for other positions of office bearers and Members of the Executive Committee.
